Becoming a Christian is like the beginning of a long, challenging hike. You have started on a lifelong journey to follow Jesus. You will need many things for a successful journey as a Christian, things like trust in Jesus, God's Word, and the church. Sometimes, it will be hard, and you might even want to give up. At times you will make a wrong choice, like a wrong turn, and you might end up

somewhere you shouldn't be. The good news is that God will always be with you, no matter what you do or where you go, and He will always love you.

How many people in the world are perfect?

If you said zero, you're right!

Even kids who never get into trouble at school or adults who make rules for you to follow are not perfect. Jesus is the only perfect person who ever lived. He came to earth to take the punishment for all the sin of the imperfect people. That means that even though you are a Christian now, Jesus knows you won't be perfect. You will still mess up, but now you trust in a perfect Saviour who will forgive your sins.

Jesus gives Christians grace and mercy when they sin. Jesus provided mercy by taking the punishment for our sins, and He gives grace by offering a free gift of forgiveness.



GRACE is receiving a blessing that you don't deserve. MERCY is not receiving punishment that you do deserve.


Read Ephesians 5:1






### Day 3:

Which "fruit" do you struggle with the most?


What might help you to cultivate this "fruit" in your life?
